



MD Chapter H FIRE HOUSE CHALLENGE GUIDELINES



The main objective of the **Fire House Challenge** is to support the Fire Departments. While doing that we get to have some good food, a lot of fun, and some good riding (weather permitting). The guidelines are few and very easy.

1. Visit a fire department for any of their fundraisers such as breakfast, BBQ's, chicken dinners, even events such as Paint Night or Christmas Gardens.
2. Each time you visit, make sure you get something signed and dated (e.g., your receipt) by one of the fire house staff. Once you do this, please give it to Marge Nagel so she can keep track of your visits – which brings us to point 3.
3. Hopefully all **Chapter H** members have received the **Fire House Challenge Pin**. If you do not have one, please see Marge. At the end of the year anyone who has visited any fire department six (6) or more times, will receive a year bar to go on their **Fire House Challenge Pin**. These bars will be given out at our holiday party. It does not matter if you visit the same fire station six (6) times or if you go to six (6) different stations. Just make sure you have something signed and dated and have given it to Marge. Don't limit your visits to six (6), the more the better – you just need six (6) to get the year bar.

A list of some of the upcoming fire departments' events can be found on the Home Page of our Chapter H Website and we also have some printed sheets if needed. But these are only some events, not all. So if you see a fire station that is having an event, let us know and we can get the word out. These visits can be anywhere – Harford, Cecil, Baltimore, Pennsylvania, anywhere you are riding. You do not have to be on the motorcycle to enjoy these events. Two, three, or four wheels – it doesn't matter, if you are out riding and see one for that day, stop and enjoy.
